

## Information to Authors

**The Japanese Journal of Thrombosis and Hemostasis** publishes papers on all aspects of thrombosis and hemostasis. Articles may cover both basic and clinical research. These may be reported in Japanese or English as full papers, case reports, rapid communications, reviews, topics, technical notes, and letters to the editor. Manuscripts will be peer reviewed and processed by the Editorial Board. Authors are requested to be members of the Society but this stipulation is not a prerequisite for submission of papers. Manuscripts that are submitted for publication elsewhere or have appeared in other published formats (excluding abstracts) will not be considered for publication. Research that involves human or animal subjects should follow the ethical standards as set out under “The Declaration of Helsinki” and “The Authorized Animal Welfare Guide”, respectively. A written statement to this effect, where appropriate, should accompany any submitted manuscript that is to be considered for publication by the Society.

**Manuscripts** should be typed double spaced on one side of the paper only and contained within 2.5cm margins. All pages should be consecutively numbered, the title page being number one. Manuscripts must be sent in quadruplicate, one original and three complete copies. The title page should contain the following: (i) the title of the paper, (ii) the name(s) of the author(s), (iii) the institution where the research was carried out, (iv) a short running title of not more than 40 characters (including spaces), (v) up to five key words and (vi) the name, address, telephone and facsimile number of the corresponding author.

**Original papers and case reports** should appear with an Abstract (not to exceed 300 words), Introduction, Materials and Methods (or Patients), Results, Discussion, Acknowledgment, References, Tables and Figure legends. The length of the text and the number of tables, figures and references are not limited but a premium will be put on concise writing and the use of the most relevant up to date references.

**Rapid communications** should not exceed 5 typed pages of text and contain no more than 3 tables or figures. Sections of the manuscript may be combined for brevity such as Introduction, Methods, and Results and Discussion. Upon submission of the manuscript, authors are requested to enclose a letter to the Editor-in-Chief requesting consideration for rapid communication and a special fee of 10,000 yen for rapid processing. This fee is non-refundable even if the manuscript is not accepted for publication.

**Reviews, topics and technical notes** are normally seconded but individual suggestions are welcome. Authors should contact the Editorial Board before considering submission of a review paper. **Letters to the editor** should not exceed 4 typed pages of text and contain no more than 2 tables or figures.

**References** should appear as superscripts in the text, numbered consecutively and compiled at the end of the article according to the order of citation. They should be typed double spaced under the heading References. Individual citations are arranged accordingly : the names of all authors, the entire title of the article cited, the abbreviated name of the journal (according to the January issue of Index Medicus), the volume number, the first and last page numbers and the year of publication. In the case of books, the citation should include the names of all authors, full title of the chapter followed by in the names of all editors (eds), full title of the book, place, publisher, and year of publication and the first and last page numbers. Note the following examples.

For a journal article:

**Units.** The Journal will adopt the System International (SI) Units nomenclature (see *Quantities, Units, Symbols*, 2nd edition London: the Royal Society of Medicine, 1975). Authors submitting manuscripts should follow this protocol. The basic SI units for measurement are: m or mm for length, kg or mg for mass, min or s for time, mol or mmol for amount of substance and l or ml for volume.

**Illustrations** are referred to in the text using Arabic numerals as follows: Fig. 1., Fig. 2 or Figs. 3 and 4. Original diagrams should be drawn twice the scale so that in final reproduction, letters and symbols are large enough and lines are sufficiently thick enough to permit half reduction. Glossy clear prints may be accepted instead of original diagrams (line drawings). Photographs and photomicrographs should be submitted as unmounted glossy prints. Diagrams should be formatted to a size of at least 13 cm × 9cm. Photographs should be formatted to a size of 21 cm × 14 cm. Where appropriate, magnification scale bars should be included. All figures must be submitted in triplicate and identified on the back with a penciled notation indicating the figure number, the first author's name and the top of the figure. Color figures are acceptable, but the costs for publishing such figures will be incurred by the author(s). **Figure legends** should be typed on a separate sheet.

**Correction** of galley proofs is the responsibility of the author. Any substantive changes at the proof step require editorial approval. **Reprints** are available in units of 50 for a fee charged to the author and should be ordered in advance. An order form will be sent to the corresponding author with the galley proof. **Page charges** are free with the exception of color figures, necessary redrawing and rapid communications.
